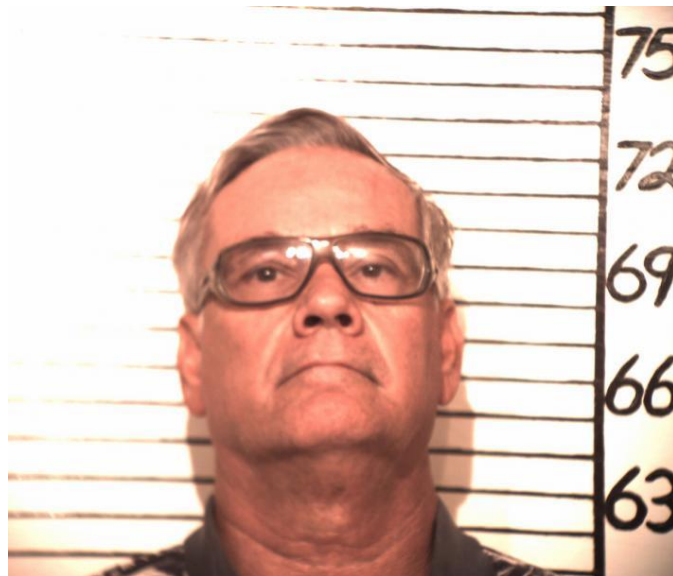


Not Guilty: Jury Acquits Ronald Perkins on All Child Sex Abuse Charges

(New Braunfels, TX) -- Not guilty on all charges. That was the verdict from a Comal County jury late yesterday in the child sex abuse case against 61-year old Ronald Lee Perkins. Jurors spent nearly all day Thursday deliberating Perkins fate before issuing the Not Guilty verdicts. If you'll remember, the Canyon Lake man was tried last year on child sex abuse charges. Specifically, he faced 3 separate indictments, each one with multiple counts all dealing with child sex crimes, including Continuous Sexual Abuse of a Young Child, Indecency with a Child, and Aggravated Sexual Assault of a Child. The jury in that trial deliberated for about 2 days before Judge Gary Steel announced to the court that there was a hung jury and he declared a mistrial. Perkins, who had been out of jail on bond following his arrest is now a free man after jurors decided that the evidence in the case wasn't strong enough to convict him beyond a reasonable doubt and they found him Not Guilty of all charges.
